RESOLUTION OF THE BERKELEY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO A.C. SCHULTES, INC., FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE WELL #4/PHASE I TEST WELL

WHEREAS, the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has undertaken the task of the construction of Well #4 as a necessary addition to the Authority's capacity to provide water to its customers; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer has prepared bid specifications for the Phase I construction of the project for a test well in connection with this undertaking; and

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2015, at the advertised time and place responses were received from the following bidders:

- 1. A.C. Shultes, Inc., Woodbury Heights, NJ 08097;
- 2, Uni-tech Drilling Co., Inc., Franklinville, NJ 08322;
- 3. Layne Christensen Company, Beverly, NJ 08010;
- 4. Tiger Construction Service Corporation, Farmingdale, NJ 07727; and

WHEREAS, after receipt and examination of said bids it was determined that the low bidder on said project was A.C. Schultes, Inc., in the amount of Three Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$393,900.00); and

WHEREAS, the submission of the bid of A.C. Schultes, Inc., has been reviewed and approved by the Authority Engineer and the Authority Attorney; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be appropriate and in the best interest of the Authority to accept the low bid of A.C. Schultes, Inc., to construct the subject project test well, contingent upon the approval of the NJDEP;

WHEREAS, the Authority has applied to The Local Finance Board for financing of the subject project; and

WHEREAS, The Local Finance Board in its meeting of December 10, 2014, approved the proposed loans to the Authority subject to and contingent upon the approval of the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey and submission of an Affidavit from the Authority; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 22rd day of January 2015, by the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That A.C. Schultes, Inc., be awarded the contract for construction of the subject project test well for the sum of Three Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$393,900.00) contingent upon the approval of the NJDEP;
- 2. The appropriate Authority officers are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with A.C. Schultes, Inc., subject to and contingent upon the final approval of The Local Finance Board since funding for the project must be obtained through the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust.
