# RESOLUTION OF THE BERKELEY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, TOWNSHIP OF BERKELEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NJ, TO ACCEPT BOND AND AUTHORIZE WET TAPS FOR PHASE III PORTION OF HICKORY FARMS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Phase III portion of the Hickory Farms Project received final approval from the Authority in March of 2007 (Resolution 2007-28) for the portion of the project in the Authority's service area; and

WHEREAS, performance bonds were never posted with the Authority in accord with requirements for the project; and

- 3. A performance bond that is acceptable to the Authority and cash portion of same have been provided to the Authority and are in proper form.

This Authority approval is with the understanding that the only portion of Phase III that is being authorized is the installation of two 12 inch wet taps on Hickory Lane and due to the period of inactivity Hickory Farms must comply with all of the BTMUA rules and regulations regarding reapplication, engineering review and bonding requirements prior to the beginning of construction on Phase III.
