# RESOLUTION OF THE BERKELEY TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REGARDING WELL #4, PHASE II REOPENING OF CONTRACT AND PAYMENT AMOUNT TO MONTANA CONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2020-26, dated May 28, 2020, the Berkeley Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") authorized payment to Montana Construction Corp., Inc., of \$73,202.22 which represented the net amount due from the final invoice of \$49,120.30 and the release of retainage in the amount of \$24,018.92; and
